

Items Accepted

Appliances:

- air conditioners
- dehumidifiers
- dishwashers
- dryers
- freezers
- furnaces
- garbage disposals
- heat pumps
- humidifiers
- microwaves
- refrigerators
- stoves
- trash compactors
- washers
- water heaters

Appliances will be in a square (non-compacted) condition and will not contain food, debris, or other foreign materials.

Does NOT include Ammonia Refrigeration!

Electronics:

- TVs
- CPUs
- monitors
- keyboards
- printers
- copiers (small)
- fax machines
- answering machines
- speakers
- CB radios
- telephones
- calculators
- cell phones
- standard phones
- electronic games

Yard Waste: Consists of grass and leaf clippings that do not contain branches. Branches cannot be larger than 3" in diameter and 5' in length.

Other:

- scrap metal (all material removed)
- car batteries
- tires (no rim)
- plastic, glass, aluminum cans, cardboard
- mattress/box springs
- furniture
- household items
- bicycles
- fluorescent lights
- carpet & pads
- misc. items
- empty propane tanks (no valve)
- gas/charcoal grills
- small lawnmowers/snow blowers (drained of gas and oil)

Items Not Accepted

- hazardous waste
- paints
- stumps
- logs
- building material debris
- lumber
- household batteries
- cement
- riding lawnmowers
- jet skis
- snowmobiles
- ATV's
- mini-bikes
- mopeds
- golf carts
- tires larger than pickup truck size
- landscape rock/timbers
- railroad ties, concrete blocks
- bricks
- garage doors
- treadmills
- home exercise/gyms/equipment

Costs

\$5 for any combination of the following recyclable items:

- yard waste
- car batteries
- 2 tires (no rim)
- scrap metal
- brush
- plastic
- glass
- aluminum
- cardboard
- one major appliance (not including electronics)

\$25 per car load of junk

\$50 per pickup or trailer load of junk

Junk constitutes items not classified as program recyclable items such as unwanted household items, furniture, carpet and pad, mattresses, box springs, misc. items, etc.

Additional fees apply for the following items:

- \$2 per fluorescent bulb
- \$2 per tire w/o rim (limit 10)

\$5 per CD/DVD player, PC/computer box, scanner, small box of misc. items (less than 15 lbs), small desk top printer, stereo receiver, VCR, phones

\$10 per additional appliance, TV (13" or smaller), mattress, box spring, grills (gas and charcoal), small lawnmowers and snow blowers (drained of gas/oil), propane tank.

- \$15 per 19" TV and monitors
- \$20 per 27" TV
- \$35 per 27" plus TV
- \$50 per console TV

Bridging Donations

Savage Rotary will be collecting donations for Bridging Inc., which assists families in transition. Bridging asks that all donations be in good condition, free of stains, tears, pet hair, undamaged and not worn beyond a respectable life. No fee will be charged for the items Bridging accepts.

Bridging will accept the following items:

Bakeware, bedding, beds and bed frames, book cases, bunk beds, couches and loveseats, desks (48"x30" or smaller), dishes, dressers, entertainment centers, glassware, kitchen tables and chairs, lamps, framed mirrors and pictures, pillows, pots and pans, rugs (clean area and throw), tables (night/end/coffee), table linens, towels (hand/wash/bath), toys (in good condition), silverware and kitchen utensils, sofa beds and futons, upholstered chairs, working toasters, toaster ovens, coffee makers, mixers, blenders, clocks, radios, vacuums.

Bridging is unable to accept:

Air conditioners, bean bag chairs, bicycles, books, carpeting/remnants, clothing, computers, computer desks, desks (large & metal), drapes, mini blinds, electric beds, espresso makers, exercise equipment, file cabinets, head/foot boards, humidifiers/dehumidifiers, knick-knacks, lawn/patio furniture, lawn mowers, snow blowers, light fixtures, medical equipment/devices, microwaves, pianos/organs, stereo systems and consoles, stoves, televisions, washers and dryers, water beds, cribs, high chairs, car seats, playpens, strollers.
