Adoption of Ordinance 2013-01

Sump Pump Ordinance

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Credit River, Scott County, Minnesota, now hereby ordains that on, the 20th day of May, 2013, the Credit River Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content, a brief summary follows:

- Section 1: Purpose – Identifies purpose of the Ordinance.
- Section 2: Unpolluted Waters Prohibited in Sanitary Sewer System – Prohibits discharged of unpolluted waters into the Township’s community sewer system.
- Section 3: Inspections and Enforcement – allows for the Township to inspect properties for compliance with this Ordinance and consequences for failure to allow for inspection.
- Section 4: Penalties for Violation – Identifies the consequences for violation(s) of this Ordinance.
- Section 5: Severability – Allows for portion of Ordinance to be severed from Ordinance if found invalid.
- Section 6: Effective Date – Ordinance is effective upon passage and publication.

The, **Sump Pump Ordinance** shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed during regular Township office hours which are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. An additional copy of the Ordinance will also be on file at the local public library and the County Law Library.
