A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SCOTT COUNTY HIGHWAY 8 CORRIDOR STUDY

WHEREAS, Scott County identified the need to establish long-range goals, objectives, and a vision for the County Highway 8 corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Townships of Cedar Lake, Credit River, Helena, New Market, Sand Creek, and Spring Lake have jointly participated in this multi-jurisdictional corridor study of County Highway 8 to develop a long-range vision for the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Scott County 2030 Transportation Plan identifies County Highway 8 as a future principal arterial roadway; and

WHEREAS, the traffic forecasting, safety analysis, existing infrastructure conditions, land use plans, and the makeup of the regional transportation system were evaluated as part of this study; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board understands the importance of the supporting road network and access management and spacing in order to promote safety and efficient operations of the roadway as well support the future function of the corridor as a principal arterial roadway; and

WHEREAS, the study findings and recommendations were developed through input and participation from the multi-jurisdictional team and a public engagement process; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board and County acknowledge the findings and recommendations of the County Highway 8 Corridor Study; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board and County commit to working together to implement the future transportation vision for the County Highway 8 corridor primarily through supportive land use decisions that incrementally preserve right-of-way, build supportive and connected local roads, and limit private access to the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the County commits to seek highway funding opportunities, when available, to address infrastructure needs on the corridor consistent with the transportation needs identified in the Corridor Study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Credit River Township Board hereby supports the County Highway 8 Corridor Study and its findings and recommendations.
