

Scott County landfill denied

Permission to construct and operate a sanitary landfill in Credit River Township, south of Savage in Scott County, was denied Thursday night by members of the township board.

The board's action followed a recommendation yesterday by the Metropolitan Council Referral Committee to deny the permit for the controversial landfill project in the southeastern part of Credit River Township.

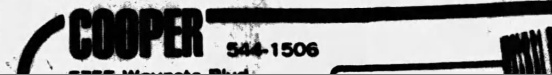
The Metropolitan Council is scheduled to consider an application for the same project next Thursday. The Council received Eugene B. Sullivan's application for the landfill Oct. 26 from the Pollution Control Agency.

Opposition to the project has been mounting from the Lakeville School District and township residents over

possible ground-water contamination, health and ecology reasons.

The Metropolitan Council Referral Committee said yesterday that the proposed landfill does not conform with policies established in the Council's Development Guide for solid waste disposal.

More than 95 percent of the Credit River Township residents have signed a petition in opposition to the landfill in Scott County, according to Attorney Conrad J. Carr, retained by a citizens group.
